## Requirements

### Clothing

Please keep a change of clothes in your child's bag each day in case of emergencies. Long dresses for girls are inappropriate as they are restrictive and impractical when climbing. School uniform is encouraged but not compulsory.

### Hats

In accordance with the school's "No Hat, No Play" policy all children must wear a hat when outside. Those without must remain in the undercover area. This is enforced year round. Children are encouraged to wear school hats; these are available to purchase at the uniform shop. Sunscreen is provided and will be applied at school. Please advise the teacher if your child has allergies or sensitive skin.

### Bags

Children will be required to bring a bag to school each day for their food and to take work and notes home.

### Recess and Lunch

Children will need to bring a piece of fruit for recess and a packed lunch. We do not have a canteen or food service available. Please advise the Principal of any allergies.

## Our Vision

### Shoes

### Library Bags

Children will be allowed to select a book from the library once a week. They may only borrow a book if they have a library bag. Library bags are requested on the school personal items list.
